Reason for change and expected benefits/business motivation:

T2S provides T2S Actors with a Statement of Accounts using camt.053 message if a respective report configuration is set up. As per UDFS chapter 3.2.2.3, camt.053 message can be subject to pagination.

Currently, pagination for camt.053 is done by splitting at the first repeatable tag in the message (as described in UDFS chapter 3.2.2.3 for all paginated messages) which is the <Stmt> tag. The <Stmt> block includes for one T2S DCA number the respective opening/closing balances followed by repeatable sequences tagged <Ntry>. <Ntry> is repeated for each instruction that affected the Cash Balance (Liquidity Transfers and Settlement Instructions).

Currently, the single page could exceed the 32 MB size limit if high numbers of instructions are settled against one DCA. If the 32 MB size limit is exceeded, the message is backed out and the report creation abends.

The first occurrence of this situation in PROD environment is documented in INC0174413. Consequently, the customer was not provided with the respective report. In order to reconcile T2S DCAs, T2S Actors can use the T2S DCA Balance Query together with the T2S DCA Posting Query.

However, given a high number of transactions, this workaround may be comparably costly and time-consuming. Therefore, a change to the level of pagination should be introduced for the camt.053 message. This will ensure, that pages of camt.053 message comply with the 32 MB limit.

Description of requested change:

For the camt.053 pagination should be moved from <Stmt> to another level. In case the information for the camt.053 exceeds 32 MB it has to be split at <Ntry>-level instead of at <Stmt>-level. The camt.053 will thus not be split anymore at the first repetitive element.

If pagination is applied and data for one DCA are split onto several pages, these pages will have an identical <Stmt>-part (meaning that all information concerning the DCA number, owner and owner parent BIC as well as opening and closing balance will be identical to the last DCA of the previous page) and will only differ from <Ntry>-Tag on.

Proposed wording for the Change request:

(i) Update of UDFS Chapter 3.2.2.3 "Outbound traffic exceeding given size limitations" Wording proposal to be included into UDFS:

In order to indicate that a report was split, the message elements foreseen to indicate "pagination" is used

(<Pgntn> ... </Pgntn>) or for camt.053 <MsgPgntn>... </MsgPgntn>). Excepting the camt.053, A messages are is split at the first level of repetitive elements..

For camt.053 a specific procedure for splitting is implemented. In order to avoid message parts exceeding 32 MB, the camt.053 is split at element *BkToCstmrStmt/Stmt/Ntry*.

In case splitting is applied, the following page starts with the same information within the <Stmt> block as the last entry of the previous page (listing the same DCA number and the relating balances) and continues in the <Ntry> block by listing all instructions that do not fit into the previous page.

(ii) Update of current implementation for splitting of camt.053 messages

The current implementation should be amended by changing the level of splitting of camt.053. The splitting will be done at element *BkToCstmrStmt/Stmt/Ntry* containing all transactions that affected the DCA within the reporting period.

In case splitting has to be applied, the following page will start with the same information within the <Stmt> block as the last entry of the previous page (listing the same DCA number and the relating balances) and continuing in the <Ntry> block by listing all instructions that did not fit into the previous page.

(iii) Update of message documentation of camt.053

The message documentation for camt.053 (no schema impact) should be enriched: Inclusion of specific information at level <Ntry> where pagination is applied.
