Reason for change and expected benefits/business motivation:

The automatically generated T2S invoices are provided to the CSDs and NCBs on the 1st T2S settlement day of each month. The due date for the resulting payment corresponds to 15 T2S settlement days after the issuance of the invoice, namely on the 16th T2S settlement day of the month (based on the T2S Calendar).

Currently the parameter "payment due date" in the Billing module has to be set up manually by the T2S Operator for each invoicing cycle. For this monthly action, the T2S Operator relies on a list of dates that the T2S financials team prepares on a yearly basis.

The parameter could be linked to the invoice's issuance's date ("invoice date") according to the T2S Calendar in order to adhere to the operational requirement to represent 16th T2S settlement date of the month. The T2S Calendar already exists within T2S and might be used to link the two parameters.

This change would eliminate a need for manual adjustments by the T2S Operator and minimise a risk of communicating inconsistent payment deadlines to T2S Customers, which are further a basis for the calculation of late payment penalties to T2S customers (in line with the dunning procedures established for the T2S billing process).

Description of requested change:


The parameter "payment due date" should have a default value of "15" and linked to the parameter "invoice date" as well as the T2S business days calendar. Consequently it would automatically show the correct date for the invoice due date, i.e. the 15th T2S business day after the invoice date. This requires a change to the nature of the parameter as it currently contains a counter of calendar days and not of business days.

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¹ In case of erroneous invoice T2S Service Desk will generate a new invoice after cancelling the erroneous invoice. The payment due date of the new invoice will be linked to the "invoice date" and would fall on the 15th business day after the date on which the new invoice was generated.
